The Home Office requires Tier 4 Sponsor Licence holders to gather information about previous UK study, and to declare this information when issuing a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) to a student for a Tier 4 visa application. The CAS must confirm that the student's course constitutes 'academic progression' in relation to previous study, and errors/missing information could have implications both for the Tier 4 Licence and the student's visa application. In addition, the Home Office's [time limit on study](#) means that students and institutions need to be aware of previous study in case any further study is not possible within the immigration rules.
